

What to expect when you visit Midhope Castle during Covid19.

Booking

The online booking system allows us to control the number of visitors attending the site during defined time periods thereby hopefully allowing time to enjoy the Midhope Castle experience in a safe and controlled manner. It also satisfies the Scottish Government requirements for track and trace in the event of a localised exposure to coronavirus.

Arrival

Please arrive anytime between 9am – 4:45pm (last admission). On arrival, please bring your email receipt or show your smartphone to a member of staff at the cabin and please tell them the name of the person who made the booking. The member of staff will verify your ticket. The member of staff will wear appropriate personal protective equipment including a face cover. We would request that you maintain social distancing of 2m, if you arrive at the cabin and the visitors in front of you, are having their tickets verified.

Hand sanitiser

There will be a hand sanitiser station available at the cabin. Dispensers are positioned on the front of the cabin and we request that you sanitise your hands before entry to the site.

Physical distancing

Once you have been admitted, please follow the government guidelines on physical distancing at all times for your own safety and for the safety of others. This is particularly important at the Information Board site and in front of Midhope Castle when taking photographs. Our staff will be monitoring visitors and may intervene if they feel that physical distancing is not being observed, but we're hoping this won't be needed and that everyone will play their part.

One-way System

Please observe the one-way system by following the signs which are positioned to encourage access to Midhope Castle and egress from Midhope Castle on the left hand side of the Midhope castle tarmac road.
