What to expect when you visit Hopetoun Grounds during Covid19.

Arrival

Please arrive anytime between 11am and 4pm. Our staff will welcome you on arrival at the electric gates on the driveway leading to the House. If you arrive on foot or by bike please proceed to the admissions desk at the gate, keeping a safe 2-metre distance from other visitors and staff. If you arrive by car, please stay in your car, and wait for one of our friendly team to call you forward. On arrival, please tell us the name of the person who made the booking so we can check you off our list. Please bring your ticket with you and show at a distance, to minimise contact, our staff will not take tickets from you.

Physical distancing

Once you have been admitted, please follow the one-way routes in place and please follow the government guidelines on physical distancing at all times for your own safety and for the safety of others. Our staff will be monitoring visitors and may intervene if they feel that physical distancing is not being observed, but we're hoping this won't be needed and that everyone will play their part.

Toilets

The toilets in the Stables wing will be open, in line with Scottish Government regulations you are required to wear a face covering if you use the facilities. Please follow the one-way system in place and keep a 2-metre distance from other guests and staff. The toilets will be thoroughly cleaned every day and our housekeeping team will be on hand all day carrying out further regular cleaning.

Hand sanitiser

There will be a hand sanitiser station outside the toilets and we kindly ask that you sanitise your hands before entering the toilets. You are strongly advised to bring your own hand sanitiser too.

Dogs

Dogs are very welcome in the grounds of Hopetoun but must always be kept on a lead. As usual, we ask all owners to bring their own poop bags and clean up after their dog. There is a water bowl in the colonnades for thirsty pets.

Food & Drink

Sadly, The Stables Kitchen is not yet open, so please feel free bring your own food & drink and have a picnic on the lawns behind the House, with a view of the pond and the fountain. Barbecues are not permitted and of course please take your litter home.
